

Asbestos Notification

Asbestos is an issue we have been dealing with for several years. The Asbestos Hazard Emergency Act of 1986, referred to as AHERA, was enacted by Congress. AHERA was enacted to determine the extent of and to develop solutions for any problems schools may have with asbestos.

As required by AHERA, a certified asbestos inspector and management planner must inspect all school facilities and develop a management plan for each facility that contains asbestos. A copy of this asbestos management plan is available for your inspection in the USD #289 administrative offices during regular business hours.
