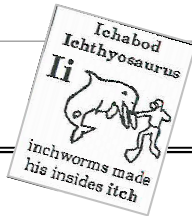


THIS WEEK IN KINDERGARTEN:

We worked on the letter Ii this week. We practiced writing Ii and brainstormed words that begin with both the short and long vowel sound. We learned that Ii and Ee can sound similar, so we have to listen extra hard! For our letter of the week craft, we made "interesting insects" and hung them in our classroom. We each named our insect too!
