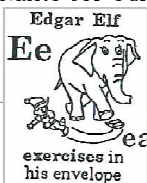


THIS WEEK IN KINDERGARTEN:

Letter of the Week was: Ee

We practiced writing the letter Ee. We also brainstormed words beginning with Ee. We talked about how tricky the Ee can be when we try to sound it out. I briefly discussed vowels and how they all try to trick us, so we have to work hard to hear the right one. We used our handprints to make elephants for our letter Ee craft!



In Math:

We began our chapter on recognizing, counting and writing our numbers 0-5. These can be difficult to write, so we will be concentrating on these next week as well.

Lowercase Letters Info:

We learned the song "Hang Your Bottoms Down," which says that some lowercase letters are tall (ex: d, f), some stay on the wall (ex: a, c) & some "hang their bottoms down" (ex: g, j).

Math Games/Songs We're Using

- To reinforce counting & number recognitions we play the "Dancing Plate Game": each plate has a number on it. When the music stops, kids must go to a plate and what ever number is on the plate is the number of kids that can be there.
- To reinforce numerical order and number formation we sing "Chant and Write".

Sight Words: a I

We can read two words now!! 'A' and 'I' are our sight words
